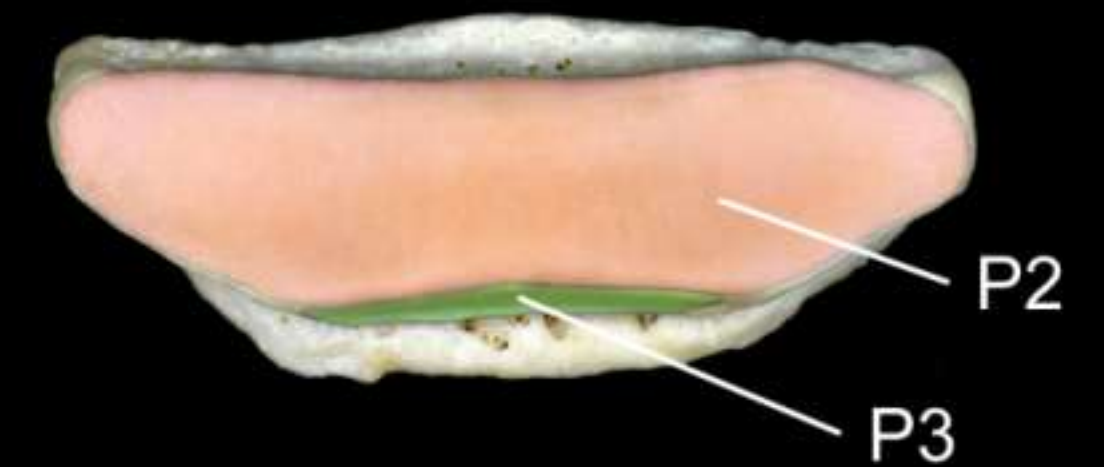

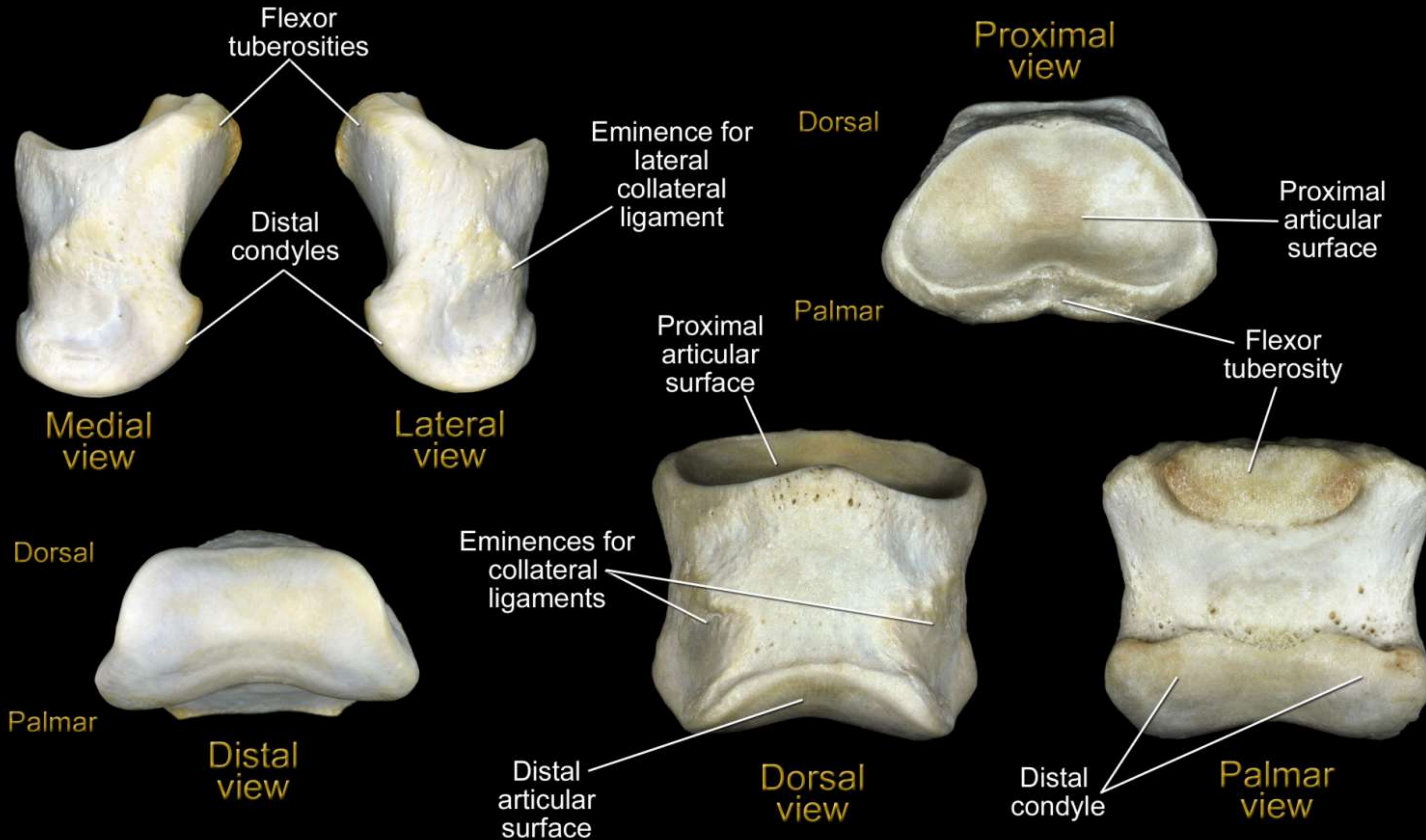

Midsagittal section of the Equine digit

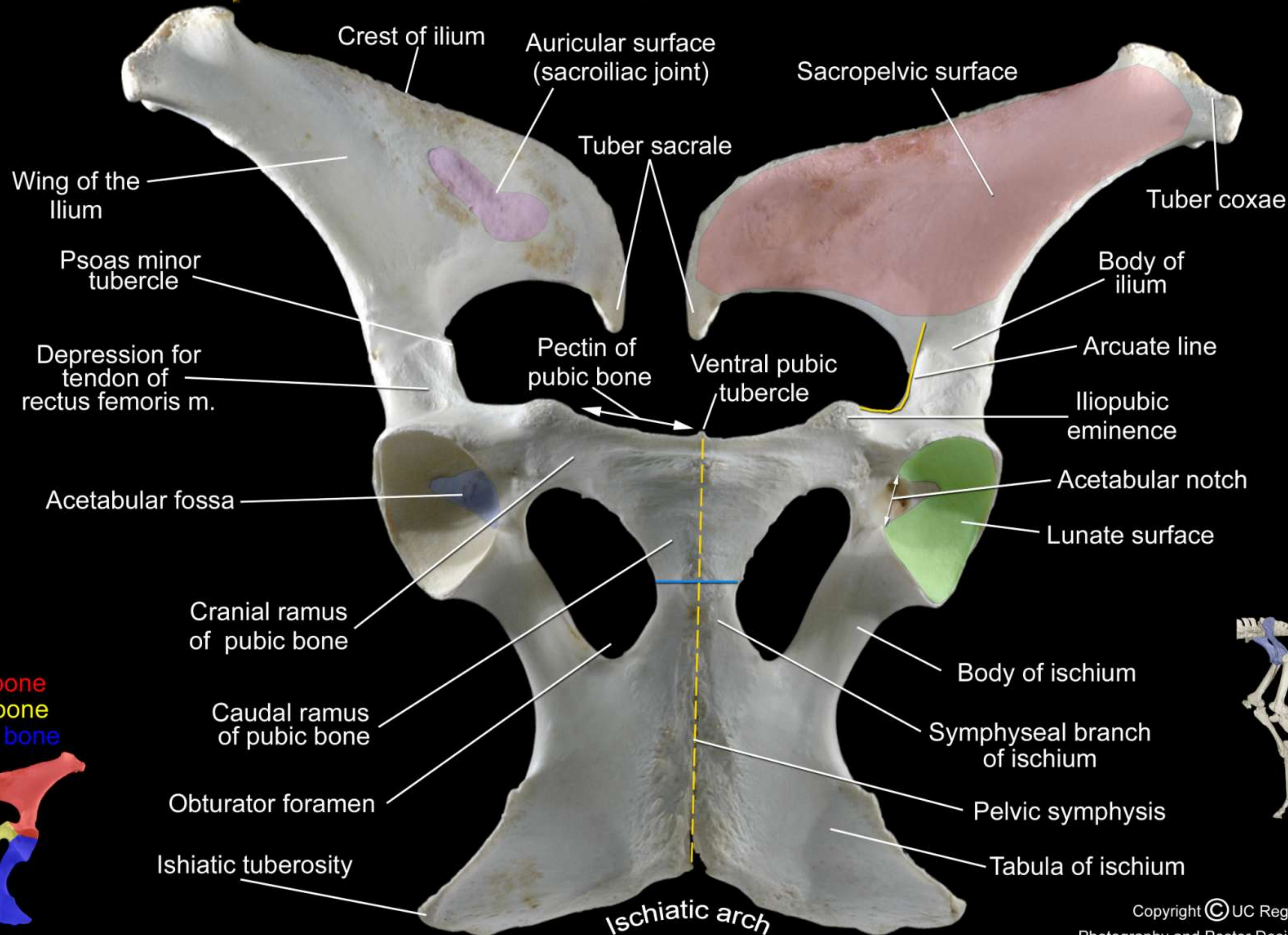

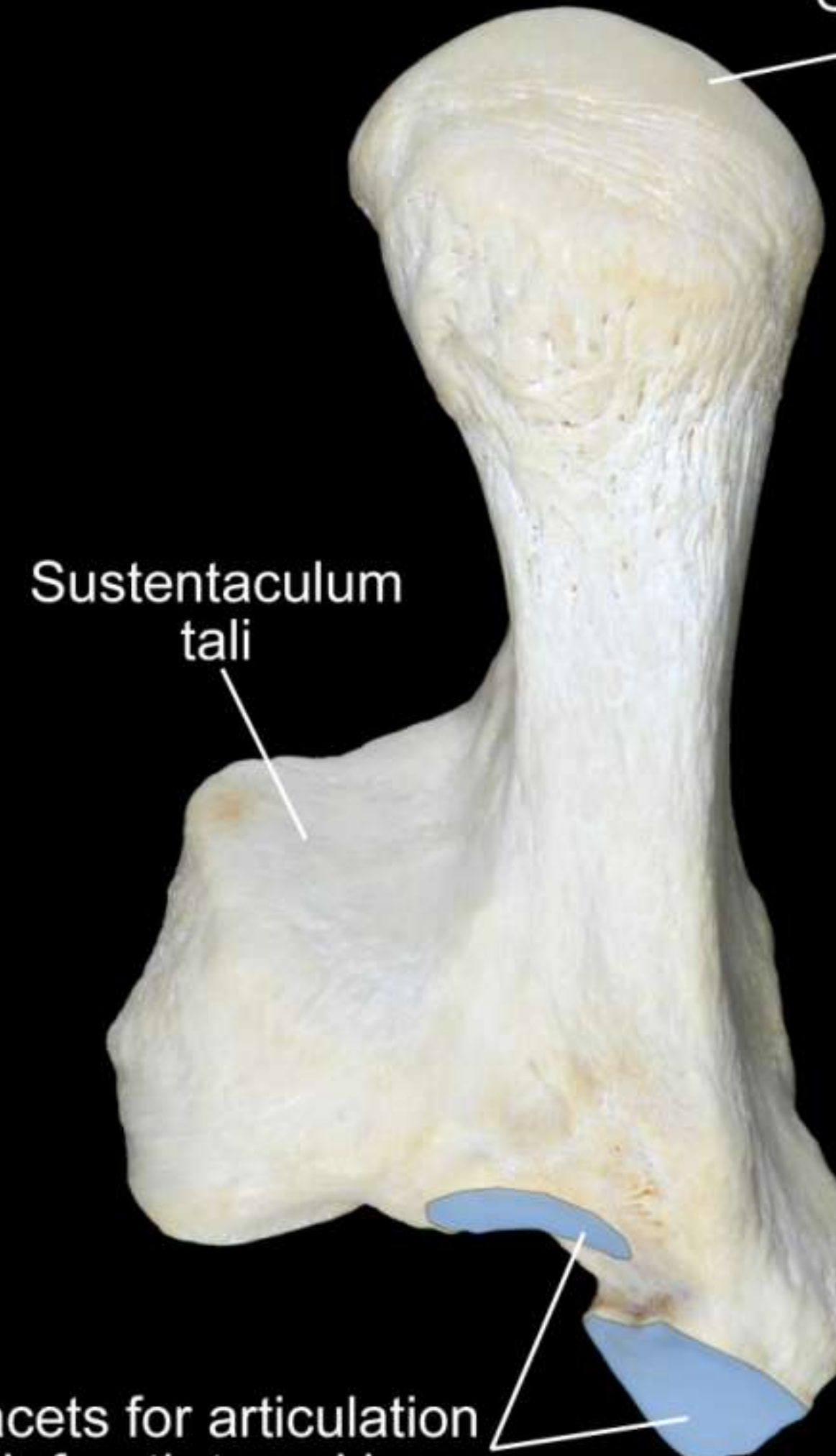
